

The O'Dwyer Arts Centre

The O'Dwyer Arts Centre is located in the village of Lismirrane and is owned by the O'Dwyer family. This is the old school house which has been turned into the art centre.

The North Mayo **Community Employment Scheme** has two workers at the centre. One is the caretaker and he takes care of all the maintenance of the building and the grounds. The other is a Clerical worker which looks after all the booking and the accounts and arrange art project for the centre. Without the support of the CE Scheme workers the centre would not be able to stay open.

The centre holds Life Drawing, Potter workshops, Printing workshops and Irish music night. The O'Dwyer Cheshire Home uses this facility for social evenings.
